- Born in AL-Simawa - Bachelor degree in Management and Economy - Baghdad University 1972 - high diploma in regional development planning 1985.

Before 2003:

- Specialist for 14 years in the national administrative development and consultant center / Baghdad.
- Prepared dozens of published studies and researches in administrative development, planning and auditing. And registered under the Iraqi administrative qualifications finding body. A lecturer in the subjects of evaluating the government performance, auditing and development.
- A supervisor over the administrative development directorates of the ministry of local governance, transportation and communications, housing and reconstruction, Baghdad municipality and ministry of interior for six years.
- A Director General in the ministry of Industry and a lecturer in the ministry of High Education for three years.

- Quit his job in 1990 and seek refugee to Rafha Camp for the uprising in March 1991.

Not a government employee since 1991-2003.

After 2003:

- Joined the Anti-Corruption committee in the governing council late 2003, and participated in the preparation of the CPI and IG's draft law.
- Appointed as an inspector general for the ministry of municipality and public works in 15-2-2005 and achieved the highest official evaluation among the Inspector Generals' in the Iraqi Ministries.
- Appointed as an acting Commissioner for CPI late 2005. Lately, the report of the US Ministry of State, which been discussed by the Congress, concerning the corruption in Iraq was published.
- Practiced his job again after obtaining 6 judiciary decisions, among them, the award of the Federal Court to cancel the discharging decision.
- Worked as a CoI Commissioner.
- Retired according to his request in 2008.
- Received the National Trophy from AL-Hiwaar center for the international researches and studies and the award (Creative) from the NGO's committee in the parliament.
